



a. Events conducted:

During the academic year 2024 - 2025, IQAC at Jeppiaar College of Arts and Science organized a series of capacity-building and pedagogical enrichment programmes aimed at elevating teaching quality, faculty competency, and institutional innovation. Further strengthening institutional teaching-learning quality, IQAC hosted a multi-day faculty development programme from 7–10 December 2024 on "Empowering Educators: Integrating Language Proficiency, Computing Skills and Aptitude Training for Enhanced Placement Outcomes." The FDP was conducted by a multidisciplinary team consisting of Dr. Lavanya L, Principal, along with senior faculty from English, Computer Science & Applications, and Mathematics. This initiative empowered educators with integrated instructional approaches to strengthen linguistic precision, digital literacy, analytical reasoning, and placement-aligned skill development in students. 
